

## MAAC Lighthouse Art Challenge

The Menominee Area Art Council's (MAAC) Lighthouse Art Challenge is open to anyone who would like to create an original piece of artwork showcasing the North Pier Lighthouse in Menominee, MI.



1. Beginning January 5, 2019, artists may download an application from the MAAC website ([www.menomineeareaartscouncil.com](http://www.menomineeareaartscouncil.com)) or pick up a copy of the application from the Spies Public Library in Menominee or the Stephenson Public Library in Marinette.
2. Artists must register for the challenge by February 1, 2019, by submitting a completed application to the MAAC at the address on the application. There is no fee to register or participate.
3. The MAAC will complete the application jury process and notify all artists by March 1, 2019.
4. Artists may work individually or in groups.

5. Artists may choose their own medium including, but not limited to, metal, fabric, glass, wood, paintings, clay, found objects, or photographs, and may create single-medium or multi-medium works of art.
6. Each original piece of artwork must be titled, dated, and signed.
7. Artwork must be portable and easily moved through a standard 36" door. Dimensions and parameters are as follows:
  - Height: not to exceed 60 inches
  - Width: not to exceed 35 inches
  - Depth: not to exceed 35 inches
  - Weight: not to exceed 200 pounds
8. Artists must deliver their completed artworks to the lobby of the former Wells Fargo Bank building at 962 1<sup>st</sup> Street in Menominee, MI, on Saturday June 1, 2019, between 9:00am and 3:00pm or on Sunday June 2, 2019, between 10:00am and 2:00pm.
9. Artists must declare whether their artwork will be offered for silent auction when they deliver their lighthouse art for entry on June 1 or June 2. Each artist will set the minimum bid for his/her artwork on the date of entry.
10. The public will be able to view and vote for their favorite lighthouse artwork in the first floor lobby of the former Wells Fargo Bank building at 962 1<sup>st</sup> Street in Menominee, MI, from Monday June 3, 2019, until Wednesday July 24, 2019. Voting will end at 5pm on July 24.
11. The public will be able to bid on all artwork that has been offered for silent auction in the first floor lobby of the former Wells Fargo Bank building at 962 1<sup>st</sup> Street in Menominee, MI, from Monday June 3, 2019, until Wednesday July 24, 2019. Bidding will end at 5pm on July 24.
12. Ribbons and certificates will be awarded at an artist reception on Saturday July 27, 2019, to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place artists based on the public votes. The winning artists and their lighthouse artwork will be recognized publically.
13. The MAAC will declare the winning silent auction bids on all donated artwork at the artist reception on Saturday July 27, 2019. The proceeds from each piece of sold artwork will be divided, 50% going to the submitting artist and 50% retained by the MAAC to go into the scholarship fund to benefit students in Menominee and Marinette counties.
14. The MAAC Lighthouse Committee reserves the right to review all artwork and accept or decline pieces prior to the show.
